Players' Code

- Maintain high standards of personal behaviour at all times - conduct yourself in a professional manner relating to commitment and punctuality;
- Be open and honest with coaches and administrators concerning your performance, injury and your ability to practice and play within the club's requirements;
- Be honest in your attitude and preparation to training - work equally hard for yourself and your team;
- Respect the decisions of the selection committee (always based on merit, performance and team requirements).

Players' Commitments

- To ensure that all clubs fees (subscription and levy) are paid on time;
- Make themselves available for selection at the prescribed time each week;
- Communicate effectively and timeously with administrators and coaches;
- Unless there are exceptional circumstances, not to withdraw from games once selected.
