

Wanderers Cricket Club Billy Adair Floating Trophy for Club Spirit

The **Billy Adair Spirit of Cricket Trophy** is awarded to the cricket member that best exemplifies the principles and values of the "**Spirit of Cricket**".

The criteria for this award are based on behaviours and actions that reflect the true essence of cricket, emphasizing sportsmanship, fair play and involvement at all levels.

The specific criteria include:

- Fair Play and Sportsmanship. The recipient shall demonstrate fairness in play and club
 life, including honest appeals, respect for the umpire's decisions, and fair treatment
 of all.
- Respect for Opponents. The recipient shall demonstrate respect for their opponents, acknowledging good performances and maintaining a respectful demeanour both on and off the field.
- Respect for the Laws of Cricket. Adherence to the laws of cricket is crucial, including avoiding actions that may be within the laws, but are not in the spirit of the game.
- Respect for the Umpires and Officials. The recipient shall respect umpires and officials, accepting their decisions without dissent or argument.
- Conduct of Players. The behaviour of recipient both on and off the field is considered.
 This includes their interactions with supporters, media, and during public appearances. It would consider the "extra mile" aspect of club life. This is done without favour or expecting anything in return.
- Recipient Conduct. The behaviour of the recipient, including how they handle wins
 and losses, their overall attitude, and how they conduct themselves throughout their
 involvement of their club life.



 Positive Influence. The recipient that positively influences the club, players and other bodies, set good examples for others, and contribute to the promotion and development of the game of cricket at the club and in the boarder community and the spirit of cricket are given recognition.
